

APPROPRIATE ATTIRE

During the course in Neurosurgery Department, Students are required to wear the following attire:

- white , Clean and ironed coat with the logo of the department (with a front zip)
- closed toe shoes with white sole
- to enter the exercise room student must have a photo ID located at the top left side of the coat
- under the coat should be worn proper clothes appropriate to the ongoing activities eg. a white T-shirt and gentlemen: shirt, shirt and tie, ladies: blouse.
- during the classes is forbidden to wear: watches, rings, bracelets, rings, or other objects on the hands
- nails should be kept short and clean, Hair should be kept clean and neat



During the classes in the Neurosurgery Department forbidden is admission students who:

- with bags, purses or backpacks
