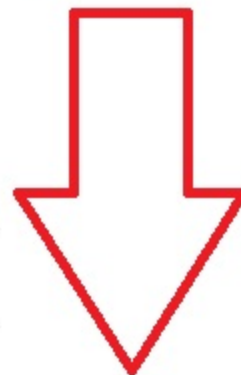



4. decyzję kuratora oświaty o uznaniu świadectwa – w przypadku prowadzenia takiego postępowania,
5. zaświadczenie potwierdzające, że uzyskane poza granicami Polski świadectwo uprawnia do ubiegania się o przyjęcie na studia wyższe w państwie, w którego systemie edukacji zostało wydane, o ile na świadectwie nie widnieje taka adnotacja, wraz z tłumaczeniem tego dokumentu,
6. zaświadczenie o wynikach egzaminu maturalnego z poszczególnych przedmiotów, suplement obejmujący przedmioty wraz z uzyskanymi ocenami (jeżeli nie są wskazane na świadectwie lub innym dokumencie uzyskanym za granicą), wraz z tłumaczeniem tego dokumentu,

Nabór na studia kandydatów legitymujących się świadectwem dojrzałości uzyskanym za granicą, następuje na podstawie konkursu (rankingu) sumy punktów uzyskanych na świadectwie dojrzałości z trzech przedmiotów objętych postępowaniem kwalifikacyjnym oraz oceny predyspozycji kandydata - na kierunkach: architektura krajobrazu, edukacja artystyczna w zakresie sztuk plastycznych, edukacja artystyczna w zakresie sztuki muzycznej, logopedia.

Punktacji przedmiotowej ze świadectwa dojrzałości w skali nieporównywalnej do zamieszczonych w załączniku nr 3 do Uchwał nr 305 i 306 Senatu Uniwersytetu Warmińsko-Mazurskiego w Olsztynie z dnia 29 maja 2018 roku w sprawie zasad i trybu przyjmowania kandydatów na I rok studiów na rok akademicki 2019/2020 nie przelicza się. Oznacza to, że kandydat nie może być bezpośrednio kwalifikowany w konkursie świadectw dojrzałości, lecz:


1) W ramach rekrutacji jednoczęściowej obejmującej konkurs świadectw dojrzałości - zobowiązany jest przystąpić do egzaminu wstępnego ustnego z dwóch przedmiotów:


- a. na kierunkach: bioinżynieria produkcji żywności, biologia, biotechnologia, chemia, dietetyka, gastronomia - sztuka kulinarna, gospodarowanie surowcami odnawialnymi i mineralnymi, inżynieria maszyn rolniczych, spożywczych i leśnych, inżynieria przetwórstwa żywności, leśnictwo, mikrobiologia, ochrona środowiska, ogrodnictwo, pielęgniarstwo, położnictwo, ratownictwo medyczne, rolnictwo, rybactwo, technologia żywności i żywienie człowieka, towaroznawstwo, weterynaria (studia w języku polskim), zootechnika, zwierzęta w rekreacji,

Egzaminy oceniane są w skali 1-6. Egzamin zostaje uznany za pozytywny w przypadku, gdy kandydat uzyska z obu przedmiotów oceny co najmniej 3. Wynik egzaminu z języka obcego z oceną 6,0 (celujący) - język kraju, w którym kandydat uzyskał świadectwo dojrzałości. Uzyskana średnia ocen pomnożona przez współczynnik konkursu (rankingu) świadectw dojrzałości.

School of Medicine is running full-time studies – at the six-year Medical Doctor Program in English (12 semesters).

The university uses international education standards to prepare prospective doctors for medicine in the 21st century. The extend curriculum is based on strict European and U.S. standards and on integrated educational experience. All lectures, seminars and practical training are conducted in English.

Students have plenty of opportunities to join research teams in many academic departments, get experience in research. Studies of the Medical Program are preparing to work in the medical profession. Student enquires the skills of interviewing the patient, examination, proper diagnosis and treatment of the patient and provide them necessary assistance.

During the studies, students gain the knowledge and practical skills in prevention, treatment and rehabilitation which are necessary to practice medicine, further training and further research. Student learns the moral principles of conduct towards patients and their rights, rules of professional doctors co-operation and moral norms in medical research. Is aware of the legal and professional responsibility. After graduation student has theoretical knowledge and practical skills to practice medicine, also has opportunity to specialize in different areas of medicine.

After graduation students will receive a diploma of Medical Doctor (MD), which allows for applying for a license to practice medicine in USA, Canada, Europe and many other countries.

Cost of studies:

1st year - 48000 PLN

2nd-6th year 46000 PLN

Candidates applying for admission are required to submit the following documents:

- 1. application form** printed out using the appropriate application form,
- 2. matriculation exam certificate** or document (diploma) confirming the right to study at universities in the country of issue of the certificate (diploma), authenticated or provided with an apostille and translation thereof into English or Polish by a certified translator (for exam certificates issued in languages other than English and Polish),
- 3. four photographs** with dimensions of 35 x 45 mm, on a light background, and a photograph in electronic form (JPG format) on **CD**,
- 4. proof of payment of the enrolment fee**

The application form is available on the UWM website. Once the form is completed and signed, submit it to the Faculty Admissions Committee with other above mentioned application documents within the time limit specified in the schedule of admissions.

The date of receipt by the Faculty Admissions Committee shall be decisive, not the date of postmark.

Students have plenty of opportunities to join research teams in many academic departments, get experience in research. Studies of the Medical Program are preparing to work in the medical profession. Student enquires the skills of interviewing the patient, examination, proper diagnosis and treatment of the patient and provide them necessary assistance.

During the studies, students gain the knowledge and practical skills in prevention, treatment and rehabilitation which are necessary to practice medicine, further training and further research. Student learns the moral principles of conduct towards patients and their rights, rules of professional doctors co-operation and moral norms in medical research. Is aware of the legal and professional responsibility. After graduation student has theoretical knowledge and practical skills to practice medicine, also has opportunity to specialize in different areas of medicine.

After graduation students will receive a diploma of Medical Doctor (MD), which allows for applying for a license to practice medicine in USA, Canada, Europe and many other countries.
