CLASSES

Speaking about present, past and future activities and events, using the appropriate tenses. Recognizing and creating the forms of nominative, accusative, instrumental, genitive and locative in chosen nouns and adjectives. Personal pronouns, possessives and demonstratives. Basic prepositions (accusative, instrumental, genitive, locative).
