**Course syllabus – part A**  
**Summer Clerkship 3/5****SUBJECT MATTER CONTENT:****Practical training**

During a summer internship after the third year of studies, the student becomes familiar with the organization and specifics of work in an internal medicine ward. They learn about the basic procedures followed in the ward as well as the responsibilities of the staff, including patient examination, diagnostics, and care of internal medicine patients (i.e., handling documentation related to patient admission, stay, and discharge, etc.). The student performs a physical examination (of the head, neck, chest, abdomen, and pelvis).

**TEACHING OBJECTIVE:**

The aim of the internship in the field of internal diseases is to familiarize the student with the full range of activities related to work in the internal medicine department and to improve and consolidate practical skills and learning outcomes obtained during the studies.

In the Practice Journal, the student is required to record all the skills acquired and improved during the apprenticeship, as well as activities that were not included in the list of apprenticeship skills cards. 3. The performance of the skills included in the vocational practice skill card and in the professionalism and social competence evaluation card must be confirmed by the signature of the head of the professional practice. 4. The grading scale and the scores for acquired skills have been given individually for each scope of professional practice in individual parts of the Practice Diary. The final assessment of the internship is issued by the internship coordinator (the tutor of a given year of uniform master's studies in the field of medicine) and confirmed by an entry in the USOS system.
