### SUBJECT MATTER CONTENT

#### CLASSES

Polish alphabet. Pronunciation of Polish speech sounds. Numbers 1-1000. Basic vocabulary: food, places in town, family, house etc. Basic adjectives and adverbs. Participating in a conversation at the A1 level. Greetings. Speaking about present activities. Shopping. Asking for directions. Making appointments. Basic questions and talk about place and time. Determining the gender of a noun. Recognizing and creating the forms of nominative, accusative, instrumental, in chosen nouns and adjectives. Nominative, instrumental and accusative forms of personal pronouns. Possessives and demonstratives in nominative. Basic prepositions (accusative, instrumental, genitive). Conjugating basic verbs in the right conjugation in present tense.
