SUBJECT MATTER CONTENT:

Classes

Pronunciation of Polish speech sounds. Numbers: 1–1000. Basic vocabulary: daily activities, clothing, food, months, etc. Basic adjectives and adverbs. A1-level conversation in everyday situations. Talking about plans. Expressing time. Present, past, and future tense. Recognizing and forming the nominative, genitive, accusative, and instrumental cases. Basic prepositions with nominative, genitive, accusative, and instrumental case government. Personal, demonstrative, and possessive pronouns.
