Practical training - summer practice during the professional summer internship after the 1st year of study

FORM AND CONDITIONS OF VERIFYING LEARNING OUTCOMES:

Practical training-(Report)-['W1', 'U1', 'K1', 'W2', 'U2', 'U3']-1. The student is obliged to submit a completed Report - Internship Journal to the Dean's Office

of the Faculty of Medicine within the deadline consistent with the framework organization of a given academic year.

2. In the Internship Journal, the student is obliged to record all skills acquired and improved during professional practice, as well as activities that are not included in the list of professional practice skills cards.

3. The performance of the skills included in the professional practice skills card and in the professionalism and social competence assessment card must be confirmed by the signature of the professional practice manager. 4. The grading scale and points for acquired skills are provided individually for each scope of professional practice in individual parts of the Practice Journal. The final grade of the professional internship is issued by the internship coordinator (the supervisor of a given year of uniform master's

studies in medicine) and confirmed by an entry in the USOS system - W1, W2, U1, U2, U3, K1
