Violation of the principles of medical professionalism and responsibility for their own behavior. 4. Academic professionalism. 5. This course is designed to introduce you to the basic principles of professionalism and professional behavior with particular emphasis on ethical and moral principles in professional practice. By the end of the course you should be familiar with the basic definitions and the division into academic professionalism, professional and social development. You will have knowledge of the philosophical aspects of professional behavior, you will know how to act to make the patient's welfare a priority of the proceedings, how to professional conduct in doctor-patient relationships, physician-patient-family of the patient, the doctor-doctor. You will know the rules of academic professionalism, adhere of academic etiquette and academic ethical code, know the rules of professionalism in research, understand the concept of fairness in science and understand what the plagiarism is.
